The Program

Music Tuition obviously requires commitment from both students and parents. Students need to sign up for a minimum of one term to begin with, and parents are asked to provide as much notice as possible in writing, in the event that your child does not continue with their tuition. Students will be issued with a Music Lesson Diary. This book is intended to be the primary means of communication between parents and tutors. Parents are strongly encouraged to monitor their child's practice and ensure that tasks are completed. Fulfilment of this obligation will assist in maximising your child's progress.

Fees

We have a two tier system of Tutors and Associate Tutors in order to ensure the very best music tuition in our program, while offering a range of affordable options for our families. Schedule A. displays fees for our Tertiary qualified/highly experienced Tutors who can guide students to higher levels of achievement, including AMEB Exams. Schedule B. indicates fees for our Associate Tutors, skilled and enthusiastic proponents of their instruments who are keen to work with students learning for pleasure and /or at an introductory level. For some tutors we also offer group tuition, with groups of a maximum of 3 students. Fees are reduced for group tuition.

One to One Tuition

Schedule A: Tutors: 30 mins: \$34:00; 45 mins: \$49:00; 60 mins: \$64:00 per student/per lesson

Schedule B: Associate Tutors: 30 mins: \$25.00; 45 mins: \$35.50; 60 mins: \$46.00 per student/per lesson

Parents need to pay for the full term's lessons prior to students beginning tuition and should ensure that no less than 48 hours notice of inability to attend a scheduled lesson is given directly to the tutor. This includes absences occasioned by school events. In the event that due notice of absence is given, missed lessons will be refunded or made up.

Group Tuition (maximum of 3 students per group)

Schedule A: Tutors: 30 mins: \$20:00 per student/per lesson

Schedule B: Associate Tutors: 30 mins: \$15.00 per student/per lesson

Please Note: As we are offering a reduced rate for group tuition and continuity of lessons is most important for our students, parents need to sign up and pay for each term's lessons before students begin tuition, and no refunds for lessons missed by students will be given.

Instrument Hire

A limited number of instruments are available for the use of students learning through the School Tuition Program. A security deposit of \$50.00 per instrument will be charged and refunded upon the return of the instrument in good condition. Instruments are provided at charge of \$75.00 per year, and it is expected they will be maintained in good condition. Parents are responsible for consumables such as reeds and strings as well as all losses and damage.

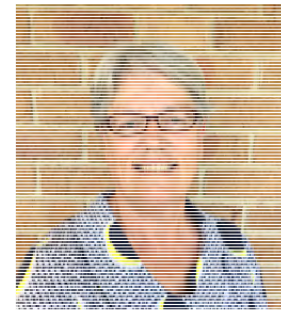

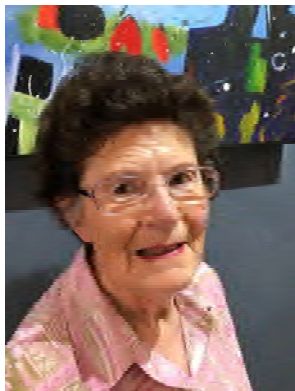
