Using Maths Online

OCS subscribes to an online learning program for Mathematics students in Years 7 to 12. Maths Online has video tutorials that clearly explain mathematical concepts with appropriate diagrams and working steps. Students may complete worksheets or practise drill exercises to build skills and confidence in Mathematics and students receive instant feedback on their progress.

Maths Online may be used in the following ways:

- Learn new concepts at your own pace/
- Review concepts learnt in class.
- Practise skills or complete homework exercises.
- Recap lessons missed due to absence.
- · Revise content for a test or examination.
- Use the one page summary sheets to prepare for examinations.


