
Leaders leading. 4M will lead in week 3, Year 6 in week 5 and Prep in week 7. All welcome!

The Higher School Certificate begins on Wednesday, 11 October. Please uphold all of our students sitting an HSC examination in prayer. This includes all of Year 12, Year 11 students doing Chemistry, Legal Studies or Modern History and Year 10 students studying VET Construction or Hospitality.

Also this term, Years 7 to 10 students will sit their Yearly Examinations.

Students are encouraged to begin revision and not leave it to the last minute. When there are several examinations, it is best to create a revision timetable. Does your child have a space where they can study away from distractions? Finally, it's not new but the Pomodoro Technique: 25 minutes study with 5 minutes break time is recommended.
