Scholarship Application Form

Orange Christian School seeks to support families to access Christian education for students of Christian leadership potential who will serve and influence the school community for the glory of God. The school hopes to offer the beneficial experience of parent partnership with the school in the education and discipleship of their children in an atmosphere of faith and prayer.

Offers of a scholarship, of up to 90% of Tuition fees, will be made to eligible families which may not otherwise be able to afford Christian education for their children.

The invitation to apply for a tuition scholarship at OCS is a vehicle for recognising Christian leadership potential in students of active Christian faith; who are actively involved, or in the case of younger children, whose family is actively involved in a local Christian church.

Process

Step 1- Complete the Application Form and submit to the Registrar Louise Borden at Orange Christian School with Supporting Documents

Step 2- The normal Enrolment process applies – please submit enrolment application forms to the Registrar Louise Borden at Orange Christian School

Step 3- Formal notification will be given in writing once the decision has been made by the selection committee.

I/ We understand that the following conditions apply to the awarding of a scholarship:

- The scholarship is for a complete stage of schooling eg: Stage 1 (Kinder – Year 2); Stage 4 (years 7-8);Stage 6 (years 11-12)
- A scholarship is applied to the annual school fees for the stage of schooling into which the student enrolls. For stage 6 students, the scholarship includes the senior secondary levy.
- Non- compulsory costs eg: enrolment in VET, or distance education subjects, are not included in the scholarship and must be paid by parents.
- A full or partial (50 – 90%) scholarship may be awarded - scholarship capped at 90%
- Scholarship applicants must include a reference from the minister/pastor of the Christian church to which the family, or the student named in the application belongs; and may include relevant references from other people or organisations. Eg. A student's employer. Sports coach etc.
